Was the course effective in helping you learn statistics? Why or why not? Yes. I entered the course with an understanding of mean, median, mode, and simple probability and left knowing how to interpret t-scores, z-scores, standard deviation, p-values as well as deploy three different distributions, run a hypothesis test, calculate an error bound and confidence interval, and brushed up on how to read box and whisker charts and combine probabilities.

What is one aspect of the course that was helpful to your learning? (Consider course organization, videos, engagement assignments, homework, coreq, etc.) Having the summary PPT slides with the steps and equations were very helpful reminders when you needed to apply the process in a project. Doing the projects was also where most of the ideas of the class would concretize.

What is one aspect of the course that should be changed? What suggestions do you have for improvement? (Consider course organization, videos, engagement assignments, homework, coreq, etc.) I did not find the WebWork questions to provide much additive value to my understanding of the concept. The language used in those questions was often so different from how the professor talked of the topic that some questions felt more like a guessing game to determine what the question's author is meaning to ask for. I certainly see the value in having regular practice that's not overly burdensome to the professor who must then grade that work. I'd say that the copious practice questions at the end of the textbook chapters would be more conceptually helpful to concretizing some of the concepts of the chapter and these could be made into a self-graded quiz or some other arrangement by contract to minimize grading time.

What are the primary strengths of Professor Norton as an instructor? She responds quickly to inquires and offers more office hours than most professors, which means you can readily reach her with questions as you're working on projects or homework. Assignments with feedback are graded quickly with detailed responses. Assignment prompts and examples are concise and clear so there are no surprises on what the professor expects to see when she grades the assignment. It's obvious that she privileges understanding the concepts of the class and is flexible with deadlines and revisions to motivate students to spend time with their work and continue to revisit components they might not fully comprehend.

What are the primary weaknesses of Professor Norton as an instructor?

I wouldn't characterize this as a weakness on the part of the professor, but I would have appreciated a deeper, theoretical understanding of the math behind the excel commands. That does seem outside the bounds of the goals of this particular class and likely I'm in the minority, which is why I wouldn't call this a weakness on your part. Perhaps a "little" way to get to this that's appropriate to this level course (granted that students likely don't know enough calculus to deal with the actual distribution functions) would be to more explicitly link concepts learned from week to week such as asking something like "how are t-score and z-score alike and different?" or "does not knowing the population standard deviation mean you'll have less valid analyses of data than if it's known?"

Is there any other constructive feedback you have for Professor Norton?

Because the engagement activities were embedded in the videos, I would only occasionally refer to the textbook when it likely would have helped me to spend much more time there. Arguably, nothing stopped me from doing so other than an already overpacked schedule, but if I had the option to read the chapter and answer problems there or have had the engagement activities on a separate sheet to complete following my reading, I likely would have spent more time with the chapters. Don't get me wrong, the videos are fine content, but I think I retain more from reading and referring back to sections of a book, which is easier to skim through than scrubbing through videos to find when the professor talks about this or that. I'm sure most students prefer a video delivery model and I'm again in the minority. Certainly, it's no surprise that I'm Elise Takehana, but if you did want to talk about the class (I recall you mentioned wanting to meet at the end of the semester), I'm happy to chat anytime.
